Library policy

Books: Maximum of 5 items - checked out 4 weeks

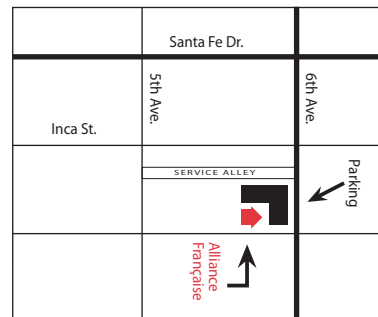

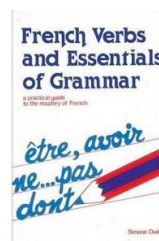

Utiliser la bibliothèque

- I want to sign-up to borrow books = Je veux m'inscrire pour emprunter des livres.
- Can you help me ... ? = Pouvez-vous m'aider ?
- How many items may I borrow? = Combien de documents je peux emprunter ?
- I want to renew my book = Je veux renouveler mon livre.
- This book is overdue. What is my fine? = Ce livre est en retard. C'est combien l'amende ?
- May I use the internet? = Je peux utiliser Internet ?
- May I use my own computer in the library? = Je peux utiliser mon ordinateur dans la bibliothèque ?
- Do you have wireless internet? = Avez vous Internet sans fil ? (ou WIFI: pronounced "wee-fee").
- I would like some information on ... = J'aimerais avoir des informations sur ...
- Can you recommend a book/a film to me? = Pouvez-vous me recommander un livre/un film ?
- My favorite author is ... = Mon écrivain préféré est ...
- Thank you for your help = Merci de votre aide.
