Do you want to learn French at the Alliance Française de Denver but find that your budget does not allow it? In 2019, the Alliance Française de Denver will grant several classes (22 to 27.5 class hours), free of charge, to scholarship recipients.

#### **CALENDAR**

- Applications will be available starting **Monday, November 5, 2018.**
- The deadline to submit your application is **Monday, February 11, 2019 by 5pm.**
- Recipients will be notified on **Monday, February 25, 2019.**
- Most French Classes are held during weekday mornings or evenings or on Saturday mornings.
- There will be four terms in 2019 Recipients are encouraged to start their studies in Spring term 2019. This is mandatory for all recipients who are granted two terms' worth of classes or more.

#### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- Scholarship recipients who have taken French before will take an assessment test to be placed in a class that corresponds to their level.
- Recipients under 18 years of age will provide a letter of agreement from a parent or a guardian. They will organize their own transportation to the Alliance Française de Denver.
- Books, membership and any other required material for classes will be purchased by the scholarship recipients.
- Class attendance is mandatory. If a scholarship recipient does not come regularly to class, the Alliance Française reserves the right to cancel his or her scholarship.
- Recipients cannot redeem French classes for cash nor for any other form of service.
- All classes granted must be taken before the end of the year 2019.
- The Alliance Française cannot grant university credits or diplomas for classes taken. A letter of completion can be issued on request at the end of the scholarship.
